<u>Suggestions on obtaining an instrument for your child:</u>

Families have a few different options when looking to obtain an instrument for their child. Many BES students use family owned instruments or instruments loaned to them by friends or relatives. This is certainly a cost effective option to consider. Instruments may also be obtained from any convenient source or rented from a reputable music dealer. Please try to obtain an instrument of good quality. Frequent repairs may cost you more in the long run and will be frustrating and discouraging to a young musician. Many inexpensive instruments now available at discount stores and on-line are of such poor quality that they break easily and are often impossible to repair. The Music Den, an instrument rental store that we partner with, conveniently delivers student rental instruments and equipment directly to our school.
