

Important Information (COVID-19)

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Unfortunately, I am informing you that an individual has tested positive for the Coronavirus (COVID-19) at Blairstown Elementary School. All parents of students who were in close contact with the individual have been notified by the Department of Health and school administration. The new definition requires 15 minutes or more of close contact, within 6 feet of exposure to an infected person during a 24-hour period in which the infected person is infectious. All students will quarantine for two weeks. Parents will closely monitor their child and inform us of any symptoms or positive cases. Also, all staff members who have been in close contact with this individual will be required to quarantine for two weeks.

Blairstown Elementary School will remain open. The district has been working closely with the Warren County Department of Health and following all rules and regulations implemented by the state and the CDC. The district will continue to work with the Warren County Department of Health.

The school is cleaned and sanitized throughout the day. Also, the custodial staff will continue to disinfect the school for the safety of all.

We will continue to monitor the case closely. We are living in unprecedented times and understand the level of concern regarding COVID-19. Please continue to wear your mask, stay socially distant, wash your hands, and stay home if you are sick.
