Blairstown Township Elementary School Preschool **program** will be accepting children who will be **3 years old or older**, on or before October 1, 2021.


We are offering a comprehensive and fun-filled program in a caring, nurturing, and developmentally appropriate environment.

Our program is in an atmosphere where young children can explore, grow, and learn at a comfortable pace.


The program will be taught by an appropriately certified teacher and will utilize the state approved, standards-based *Creative Curriculum*.



Registration Procedures

To enroll children in the Preschool Program, parents are required to do the following:

- * **Complete registration forms**
- * **Provide \$25 registration fee**
- * **Provide original birth certificate**
- * **Provide a copy of immunizations**

Since class size will be limited, if an excess number of eligible students apply, seats will be filled through a lottery. The remaining students will be placed on a waiting list.

The program will be under the supervision of the building administration.





As early childhood educators, we believe that school for each child should be a positive and successful experience. Our goal is to provide an environment that will stimulate enthusiasm and eagerness for learning.

Children will be encouraged to explore, create and experience “hands-on” activities using a variety of materials and equipment.
